The Application for these concessions should be made in prescribed Application Forms in duplicate signed by the parents along with their Income Certificates which are signed by the appropriate authority within 15 days after the admission.

WORKING HOURS: Daily working hours will be adjusted according to the climatic conditions, seasons and convenience however, the colleges generally work in two shifts morning and evening.

HOW TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION

Submission of Application Form: The Application Form for admission must be accompanied by Registration fee of Rs. 25/- only. For Physical Fitness Tests, Attested copies of Certificates and testimonials listed in the Form for admission must be sent along with the Form. Originals should be submitted at the time of interview for admission.

Merely sending Admission Form and Registration Fees does not entitle a candidate for the admission to the Course in the College. Only those Candidates who pass the Physical efficiency tests interview satisfactory will be considered for selection and Admission will be confirmed after the payment of total fees and other charges from the declaration of the selection List

Six Passport size recent Photographs of the candidate must be attached to the Application Form. Incomplete Form will be rejected forthwith.

Fees are not accepted in instalments. Total fees must be paid to confirm the Admission, if candidate fail to pay, then concerned candidate will not be admitted to the college and a person in the waiting list will be given a chance of admission in his / her place.

Payment of Fees: After selection for the admission the applicant must immediately pay all the fees and other charges. Those who fall under E.B.C. as per rules of Maharashtra State Govt. (Annual Income of the parents below Rs. 10000/-) will pay all fees except the Tuition fee.
